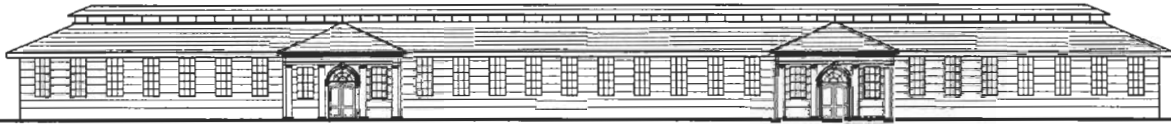

The EASTERN MARKET TEMPORARY STRUCTURE is a 245' long market shed placed temporarily on City Land. The building would have a ventilated shed roof, be air-conditioned for the extremes of weather and feature Class - inspired doorways and building features.

After South Hall is renovated the Temporary Market Hall could remain to serve the community until such time as the temporary site is rebuilt.

This public structure will testify to how our community overcame the disastrous fire of 2007.

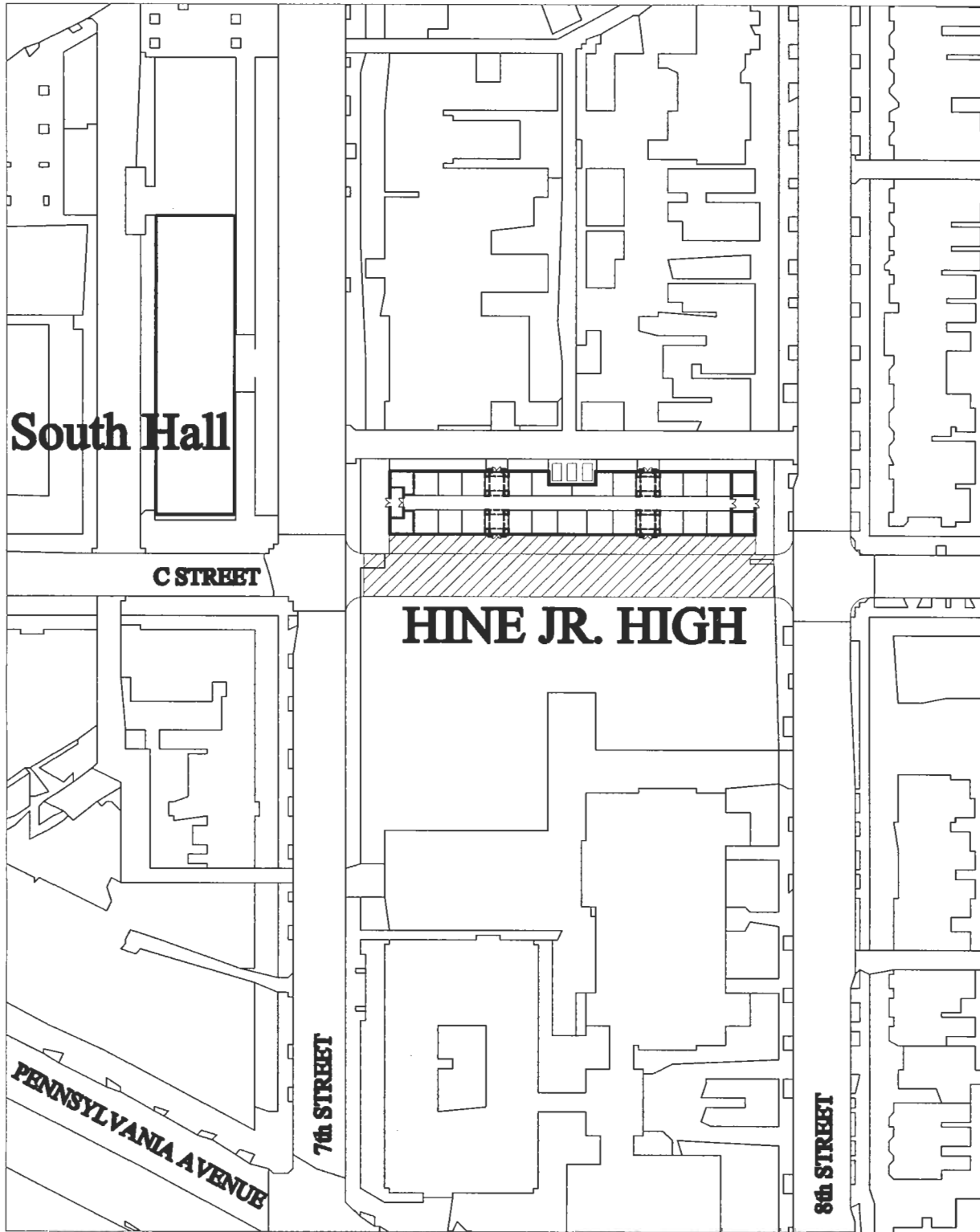

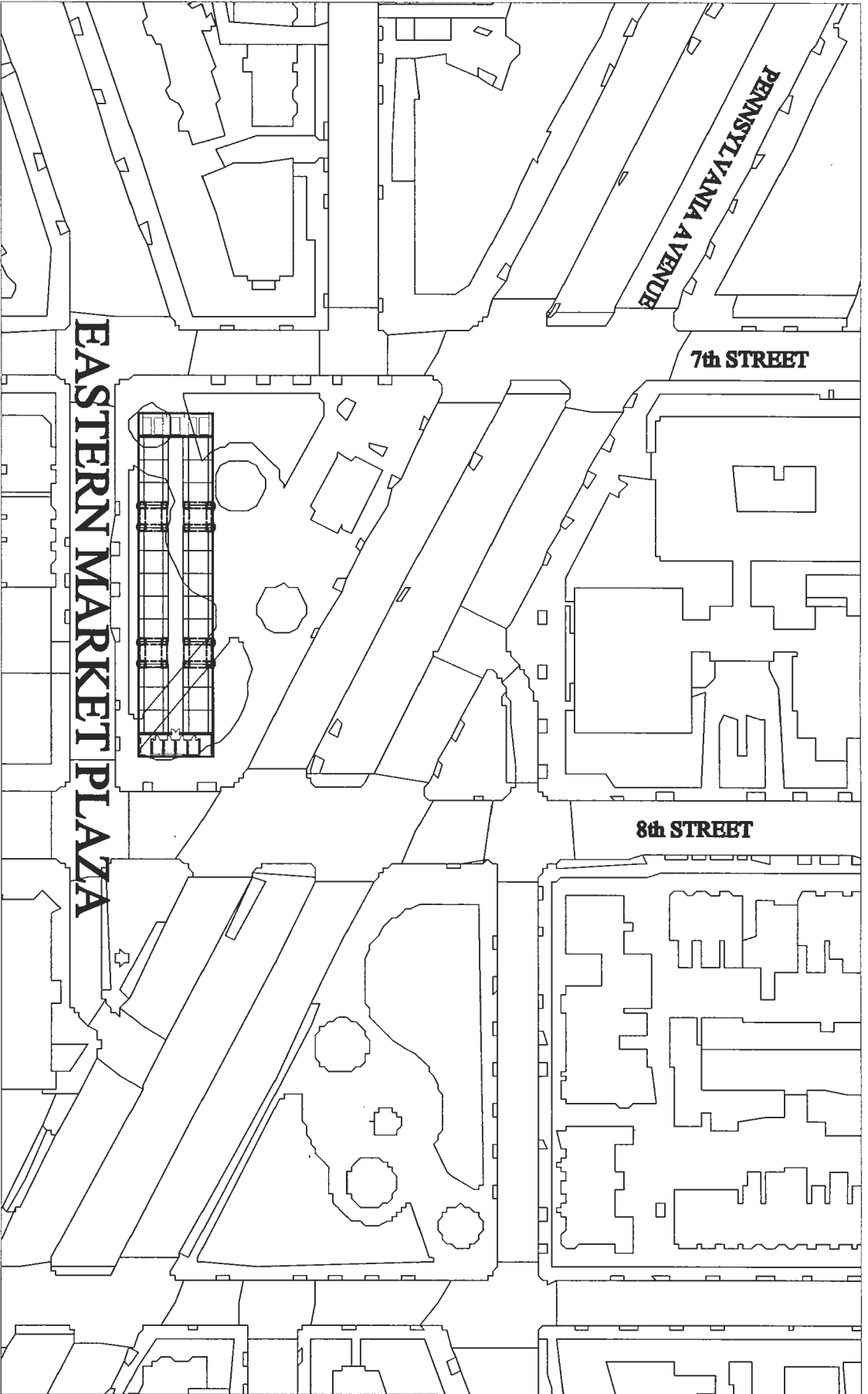

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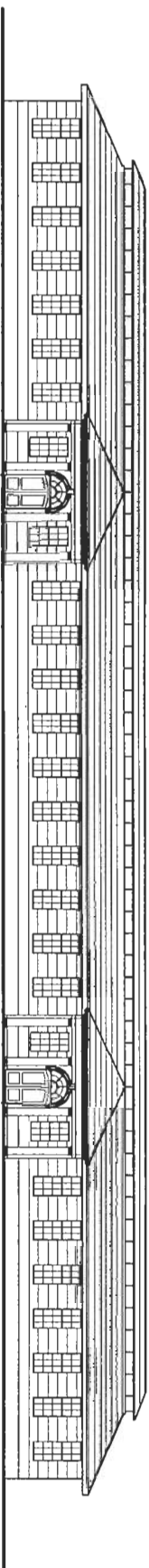

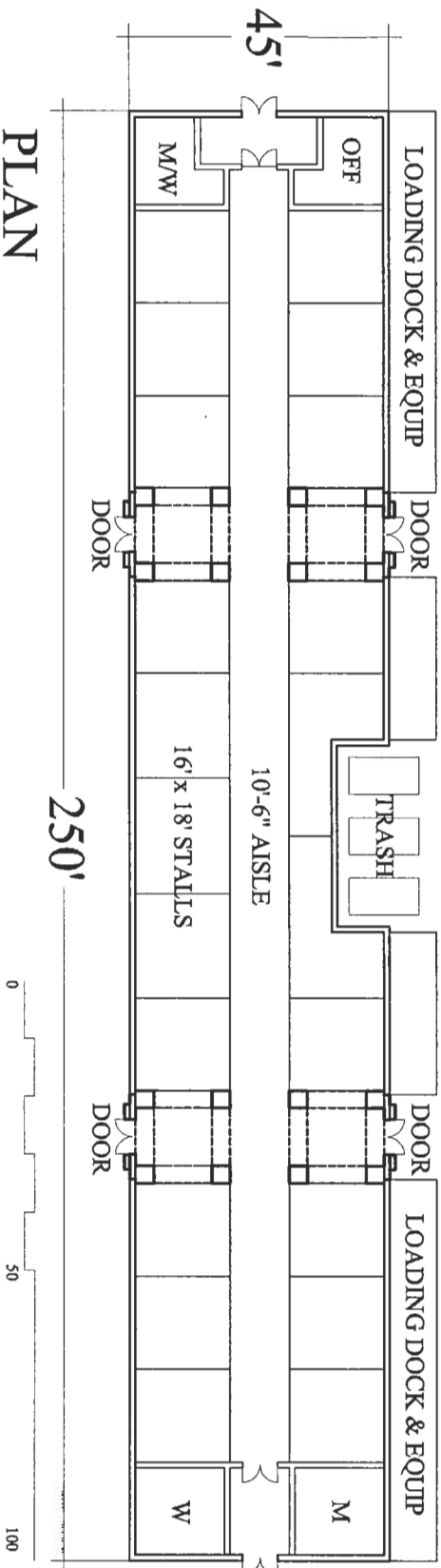

STRUCTURE

The enclosure would be of Structural Insulated Panels (SIPs) made from a thick layer of foam or agriculture fibers sandwiched between layers of Oriented Strand Board, plywood or fiber-cement. These panels provide structure, insulation, and exterior sheathing in a one-piece component.

SYSTEMS

The Market Building would be a slab on grade with the necessary plumbing, sanitary, electrical, data conduits. Storage, air conditioning, refrigeration, and trash equipment would be located along the side.

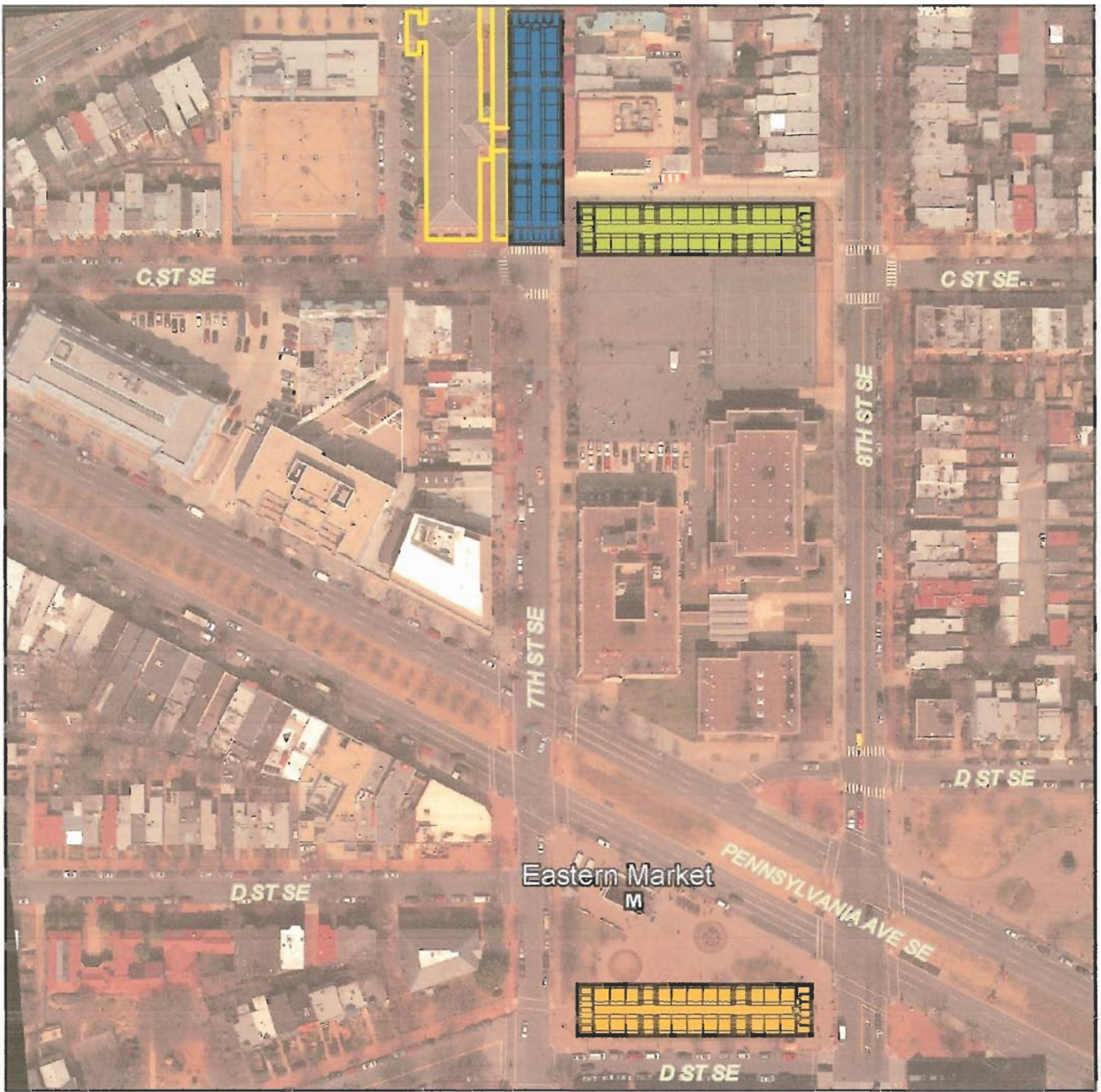

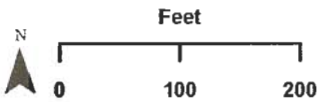
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

Potential Temporary Market Locations
